



FOUR-BALL – ZONE 3 AND 4

STROKE PLAY CHAMPIONSHIP

TERMS OF COMPETITION

Four Ball Stroke Play event. Two competitors play as partners, each playing their own ball. The lower net of the partners' scores is the Team score for the hole. The winner is the Team with the lowest total net score over 18 holes. Players are invited to enter as partners. If a player wishes to enter alone, they will be given a 'hidden' partner from the field of single entries.

- Players are expected to play **rain or shine**.
- Maximum field of 60 entries.
- Players should understand golf rules and etiquette as well as the rules and expectations of the tournament (four-and-a-half-hour pace of play), scorecard exchange, keeping of accurate scores, etc.
- Teams should be able to communicate in English or alternatively have a caddy/interpreter.

FACTOR/HANDICAP:

- Players must have a verifiable handicap factor with Golf Canada.
- Open to all players. Course handicap may not differ by more than **10** strokes as of date of entry. If factors exceed the maximum spread, the higher factor will be reduced.
- The maximum allowable handicap is a Handicap Factor of 36.4 on the COMBO Tees at Chilliwack Golf Course. Factors are frozen at the time of draw.

CARTS:

- A limited number of power carts are available. Reserve by contacting the Golf Shop at 888.757.7222

DRESS CODE:

- The dress code and cell phone policies of the host club apply.

CLUBS AND BALLS:

- List of Conforming Driver Heads: Model Local Rule G-1 is in effect. Penalty for making a stroke with a club in breach of the Local Rule: **Disqualification**.
- List of Conforming Golf Balls: Model Local Rule G-3 is in effect. Penalty for breach of the Local Rule: **Disqualification**.

CANCELLATIONS:

- The draw will be posted on the website. Once the draw has been posted, there will be no refunds. Please try to find a replacement.

PRIZES AND BREAKING TIES:

- Ties will be broken by matching scorecards, using the better back nine.
- Lunch and prizes will follow the tournament.
- The Farrell Trophy will be awarded to the winning Team.
- Runner up prizes awarded based on the number of entries.
- Individual KP and LD prizes.
